

## EQUAL PARTNERSHIPS

In 2022, 27 young Palestinians and Israelis went through 50:50's startup acceleration process, culminating in seven ventures pitching at 50:50's annual Demo Day. 50:50's program was effective in helping participants build entrepreneurial skills and cross-border relationships and creating real ventures that demonstrate positive cooperation and have the chance to become businesses.


